SPOTLIGHT: 5 Year Funding Snapshot

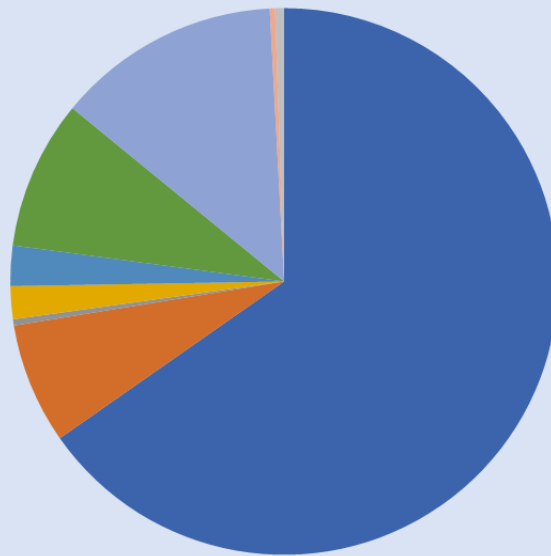
Five Year Averages
